#### Brenham

Explore the streets of historic downtown Brenham featuring an array of antiques and specialty shops, as well as a variety of Texas-inspired din lodging and historic sites. Home of Blue Bell Creameries and Blinn Col Brenham is the central hub of Washington County providing access to arts & culture, nightlife and more than 40 bed and breakfasts.

#### Burton

Home of the Texas Cotton Gin Museum offering guided tours of the re historic 1914 Burton Farmers Gin. The Burton Railroad Deport will tran you back to the 1870s when the Houston and Texas Central Railroad st there. Mt. Zion Cemetery, located on the scenic Independence Trail, ho settlers including Texas Ranger Captain Leander McNelly.

# Chappell Hill
